



I-Beam is a lunchtime literacy and mentoring program that connects volunteer adult mentors with 2nd-5th grade students who scored below the 25th percentile of MAPP testing and/or qualify for free and reduced lunch, and/or are recommended into the program by their teacher. On the same day each week, volunteers travel to a nearby elementary school for one hour of lunch and socializing and one-on-one reading with their student. For the one hour session, the mentors promote the skills and love of reading and offer consistent adult relationships.

I-Beam has completed its 6th year in partnership with many of Mt. Pleasant's elementary schools. We have grown from serving 41 students with 55 mentors from 2 churches in one school to serving 2010 students with 265 mentors from 19 churches and organizations in 7 schools. Below are the schools that we serve along with our recent survey that will give you some information on the results of the program from both a teachers and mentors perspective. 2015-2016 I-Beam Teacher and Mentor Survey Overview

97% of I-Beam Mentors ranked their overall interaction with their student as positive or very positive 94% of I-Beam Mentors plan to mentor again in the 2015-2016 school year 93% of I-Beam Mentors feel that they made a difference in the life of their student 80% of I-Beam Teachers have noticed an increase in self-esteem 86% of I-Beam Teachers have noticed a positive difference in reading skills (comprehension) 83% of I-Beam Teachers have noticed an increased level of enthusiasm for learning

72% of I-Beam Teachers have noticed a very positive difference in classroom performance
